# **Balham Nursery School Family Newsletter**


Hello Mums, Dads and Carers It has been a wonderful term at Balham Nursery School. The children's learning has come on so well, and each of them are planned for according to their own needs and interests. We know you have been meeting the teachers recently to talk about your child's progress and it is affirming to hear that there is a shared partnership with you in celebrating the successes and creating shared priorities for what comes next.

Winter activities This half term the children have had lots experiences relating to the winter season. In front class we chopped vegetables and made some delicious soup in the soup maker. Jo read the story of stone soup and someone made a connection and popped a stone in his bowl!

**Camp Fire** We had a bonfire in the garden (all safely done) and Frances our music therapist sang songs with us! We had a really lovely time and lots of children will remember this long after they leave Balham!

### Here is a National Trust bird food recipe to try at home

- Hard fat, such as lard or suet, at room temperature
- Handful of birdseed
- Handful of unsalted peanuts
- Grated cheese or raisins
- Dry leftovers like oats or bread
- Old, clean recyclable yoghurt pots or coconut shells for a plastic-free alternative
- String
- Small stick, roughly 7–12cm long

This will make one to four fat cakes depending on size.

**Safeguarding** Did you know there is lots of information on the NSPCC website which can support you as a parent with your mental health and well- being? "Changes to our mental health can sometimes affect children and their well-being. They may pick up on your anxiety or low mood. This doesn't mean you should hide or minimise your feelings. You can try to explain them using phrases like, "It's ok to get big feelings, everyone gets big feelings but it's still the grown up's job to look after the children" or "If grown-up's get big feelings it's not your fault " (NSPCC)
