
Balham Nursery School Family Newsletter

Hello Mums, Dads and Carers Welcome to our May newsletter. As ever it has been a busy month, with children embedding their learning in all areas of the EYFS curriculum. Do have a look at the curriculum progression chart in the main reception area so you can see how the curriculum helps your child develop. Most of our planning is 'reflective' which means we plan on the children's interests and fascinations and we are responsive to daily and weekly need. Our planning is shaped by time of year, seasons, celebrations and other events and covers the seven areas of learning.

For our two year olds, we will aim to find another outing before the end of term.


The chicks have hatched It has been so exciting to have the Living Eggs Company bring us eggs to hatch. We had nine successful hatchings within just a day or two them arriving.
